General Information

This event will be held outdoors in two rings.

There is ample room for parking and crating.

Food will be available at the show site.

Dogs must be exercised only in designated areas. Please clean up after your dog at the trial site and your motel.

Policy Prohibiting Alcoholic Consumption

No alcoholic consumption or open containers of alcohol are permitted on the grounds. Noncompliance could result in immediate expulsion from the event, legal prosecution under local law or both.

Entries & Acceptance

General Rule on Eligibility

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age, regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

This event will be held under USDAA® Official Rules and Regulations, a copy of which may be viewed and printed online at www.usdaa.com.

No Entry For Exhibition Only

Entries For Exhibition Only will not be accepted. Should a dog be required to jump a higher height by virtue of the judge's measure-in, it will be placed first in the running order at the higher height for all classes entered.

Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

Refund Policy

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

Charges for NSF Check/Credit Card

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution shall be assessed a \$40 service charge.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

Submission of Entries with Secondary Move-Up Date

All entries or cancellations must be received at the Secretary's address no later than the closing date, after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled. For entries received by the closing date, the level of entry into a given class may be advanced by notifying the Secretary in writing via email by the "Secondary Closing Date". No other changes, cancellations or additions may be made after the initial closing date.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number on a completed registration form.

General Entry Conditions

Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children or guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

Policy on Fault Limits

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

Prohibitions on Aids & Devices

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.

Spam Blocker

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

Refunds

A 75% refund for bitches in season or for an injured dog may be given with a letter from your veterinarian if received by the secretary prior to secondary closing on Monday, September 6.

Check-in & Measuring

Dog Measurements & Certification

All dogs not jumping 26" in the Championship Program or 22" in the Performance Program must be measured unless they have a permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration card. When not enrolling electronically, please send a copy of one the following items to facilitate the check-in process:

- photocopy of permanent dog registration card,
- printout of the dog-information page from your USDAA® competitor account, or
- copy of your check-in letter from USDAA indicating your temporary card has been accepted by the USDAA office and your permanent registration card is in process.

Class Descriptions

Team & Versatility Pairs Measure-up Policy

The handler of a dog entered in Team or Versatility Pairs must notify the secretary immediately should their dog be required to jump a higher height by virtue of the judge's measurement. The dog must jump the higher jump height in order to be eligible to earn a qualifying score in the tournament. If entered in Team, the dog may not be moved to Versatility Pairs. If the handler chooses *not* to have their dog jump the higher height, their entry is effectively withdrawn. The competitor may or may not run for exhibition only (earning no qualifications) solely at the discretion of the event secretary; there shall be no refund of fees paid.

If the change in height makes the dog ineligible for their team (three jump heights), the secretary will make every effort to form complete teams from dogs available. A move-up in height for dogs in Versatility Pairs does not affect their team composition, but may result in a change in their position in the running order because of the height composition of the Pair.

Titling & Tournament Awards

TITLING CLASSES

Ribbons and small prizes will be awarded to dog/handler teams placing 1st through 4th place in all classes in their respective jump heights and in mini and open divisions for pairs. Maroon qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score in any non-tournament classes. Rainbow colored rosettes will be awarded to those finishing a title.

TOURNAMENTS

Dog Agility Masters® Team and Performance Versatility PairsSM – Prizes and awards will be made based upon overall scores after five rounds. USDAA will provide “Gold”, “Silver” & “Bronze” medallions for the three top scoring teams/pairs. Qualifying lapel pins will be awarded to each member of each qualifying team or pair.

Grand Prix of Dog Agility® and Performance Grand PrixSM - A double maroon and white ribbon shall be awarded to all qualifiers in the Grand Prix, with a double maroon and pink ribbon awarded to all qualifiers in the Performance Grand Prix. Rosettes for 1st – 4th place will be awarded for each jump height.

Dog Agility Steeplechase®- Prize money shall be computed based upon 30% of the total entry fees to be allocated in accordance with the payout table found in the tournament rules online at www.usdaa.com. *Allocable amounts to finalist positions that are not filled for any reason or allocable prize amounts less than \$3 shall not be paid.

Performance Speed JumpingSM - Prize money shall be computed upon 30% of the total entry fees to be allocated in accordance with the payout table below regardless of the size of entry in any height class. *Allocable prize money to Round 2 positions that are not filled for any reason will be forfeited.
